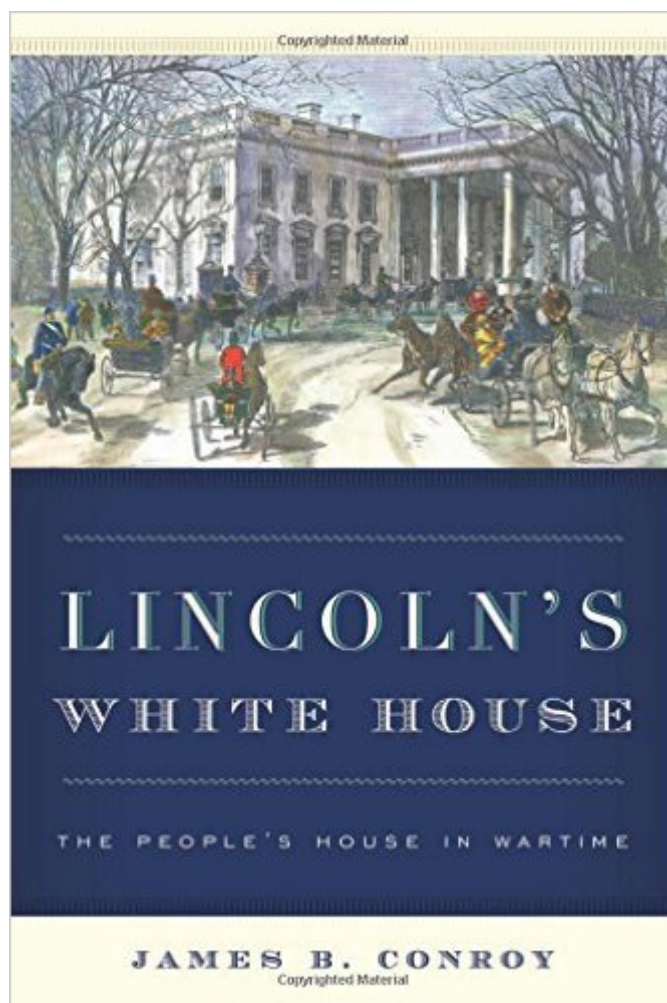


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# Lincoln's White House: The People's House In Wartime
